Guest Speakers: Dr William Faquin, MD PhD, Massachusetts General Hospital Dr Michael Henry, Mayo Clinic Rochester, Minnesota

Dr Faquin is the Chief of Otolaryngologic Pathology at the Massachusetts Eye and Ear and a subspecialist in Head and Neck Pathology & Cytopathology at the Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston. He is Professor of Pathology at

Harvard Medical School and is recognised for his contributions to the study of thyroid, salivary gland and HPV-related cancers of the head and neck. He has authored over 200 peer-reviewed publications, and has co-authored books on head and neck cytohistology, salivary gland cytopathology, and thyroid cytopathology.

Dr Faquin is a co-author of the Bethesda System for Reporting Thyroid Cytopathology, co-chair of the College of American Pathologists Evidence-Based Guidelines Committee for the testing of head and neck squamous cell carcinomas for high-risk HPV, and co-chair of the Milan System for Reporting Salivary Gland Cytopathology sponsored by the ASC and IAC.



Dr Michael Henry is a graduate of the University of Minnesota Medical School. He completed his residency at the Naval Hospital in San Diego and cytology fellowship at the University of Rochester, NY. Dr Henry had a 24-year career in

the United States Naval Medical Corps. After retiring from the Navy in 2000, Dr Henry spent time as Director of Cytology at the University of Maryland and is currently Consultant and Director of Cytopathology and Medical Director of the Cytotechnology Program, Mayo School of Health Sciences, College of Medicine, Associate Professor of Laboratory Medicine & Pathology -College of Medicine, Mayo Clinic.

He has lectured internationally on various cytology topics and held offices in several pathology organisations. He has written widely on various aspects of cytopathology and is the coauthor of the College of American Pathologists Practical Guide to Gynecologic Cytopathology.
